Structure and Governance

The AusNCP's <u>structure</u> and resourcing remained broadly stable.

Awareness raising and promotion

The AusNCP:

- presented at six events
- used social media to promote the OECD Guidelines and the AusNCP
- worked with government partners to embed information about the guidelines into e-learning
- provided material for our stakeholders' e-newsletters on the 2023 update to the OECD Guidelines
- re-launched and expanded the AusNCP website and worked to include material about the Guidelines and the AusNCP on other government websites.

Complaint handling

The AusNCP:

- closed six complaints
- had five ongoing complaints at the end of 2023.
